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Ohio State University OARDC Project

Hammontree was hired by Ohio State University, to redesign the entrance of their OARDC Wooster campus, to accommodate truck traffic and improve the general traffic flow. Civil engineering plans were prepared for rehabilitation and replacement of the pavement in the parking areas and roadway.

The Hammontree Team worked closely with OSU in the schematic design phase to get more than just a pavement rehabilitation, but a new redesign of the entrance to the campus.

Camp Y-Noah Nimisila Spillway Complete

The Hammontree Team performed the engineering and surveying tasks needed to address the ODNR inspection report and replace the failing Nimisila Spillway. Hammontree worked with Akron Area YMCA and ODNR to provide a full replacement of the secondary spillway, new bridge and abutments.

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Morris Knowles Awarded Upper Tyrone Township Sanitary Sewer Project

Upper Tyrone Township has awarded Morris Knowles a sanitary sewer project that involves design of a new sewer system for 602 residents which currently have failing private systems.

This project will consist of construction of approximately 55,000 L.F. of gravity sanitary sewer line, four pump stations, and a low pressure sewer system with 116 residential grinder pump units in Upper Tyrone Township, Fayette County. Sewage will be transported and treated at the Westmoreland-Fayette Treatment Plant.

The primary source of financing for this new sewer system is through PennVEST. Morris Knowles is responsible for assisting

with the PennVest applications and loan settlement documents and procedures, DEP WQM permit applications, general permit applications for stream crossings, NPDES permit for construction activities, and railroad crossing and encroachment permits. Morris Knowles is also contracted to perform construction observation for this project to ensure general conformance with the plans and to review and approve payment applications.

Hercules Engine Plant to be Renovated

The Hercules Engine Plant will soon be renovated into 90 apartment units with a community hub and secured parking lot.

The Hammontree Team was selected by Broadview Development, LLC to provide engineering and surveying services for Phase 1 renovations to this facility.
